

Ringstørrelser

Dette er en oversikt over ringstørrelsene fra Stavanger Museum. Når det gjelder Oslo-ringer så henvises det til egen liste.

Artene er oppført systematisk med tilhørende ringstørrelse. I denne listen er artsnummer (EURING) sløffet da arts- og underartskodene ligger i RingAccess.

For lommer, dykkere, gjess, ender, svaner, rikser, hønsfugler, tyrkerdue og trane utvikles tarsen sent på pullus. Merking må derfor ikke finne sted før tarsen er fullt utviklet.

«=» mellom to ringstørrelser betyr at begge kan brukes, men førstnevnte er å foretrekke.

«*» bak ringstørrelsen betyr at det bør benyttes stålring, kun angitt der ringstørrelsen produseres i begge typer metall.

«@» = spesialtilpasning av JD-ring

Det finnes en del spesialringer til enkelte arter:

BA – aluminiumsring med lukkeklaff for hubro og snøugle

3 - spesialring for haukugle. Den har samme diameter som vanlig 3, men er lavere (ringnr. 3075001 - 3078000).

2 - aluminiumsring med lukkeklaff for lappugle og slagugle

HA – spesialring for smålom og storlom. Den har en spiss trekantet form tilpasset fuglens tars.

N – spesialring for alke. Den har en trekantet form tilpasset fuglens tars.

J – spesialring for lomvi og polarlomvi. Den har en trekantet form tilpasset fuglens tars.

FA – ring utviklet spesielt for gråmåke og alkefugl. Størrelse mellom 3 og 4.

JD – spesialring for perleugle. Den har samme diameter som 5, men er lavere. Brukes også på tyrkerdue, men da bør man ta en avbiter og klippe av ca. 2 mm på den ene siden.

MD – spesialring for spurveugle. Den har samme diameter som 6, men er lavere.

K – ring med størrelse mellom 6 og DA.

T – spesialring for tårnseiler. Den har samme diameter som 8+, men er lavere.

For havørn og kongeørn finnes det egne prosjektringer.

Helt bakerst i listen finner dere oversikt over alle ringtyper med innvendig diameter.

Ring sizes

This is a list ring sizes of rings issued by Stavanger Museum. For Oslo-rings there is a separate list. The species are listed systematically with associate ring size. The species EURING-code are left out of this list as these are coded in the RingAccess-software.

For pulli of loons, divers, geese, ducks, swans, rails, Galliformes, Collared Dove and Crane, the tarsus develops quite late. Marking should not take place until the tarsus is fully developed.

«=» Between two ring sizes means that both can be used, but the former is preferable.

«*» Behind the ring size indicate that steel rings must be used, only indicated for ring sizes that are produced in both aluminium and steel.

«@» Adjustment of JD-ring

There is a number of customized rings for certain species:

BA - aluminum ring with a closing mechanism for Eagle Owl and Snowy Owl

3 - Special ring for Northern Hawk Owl. It has the same diameter as 3 but is lower (ring no. 3075001 - 3078000).

2 - aluminum ring with a closing mechanism for Great Grey Owl and Ural Owl

HA - special ring for Red- and Black Throated Loon. It has a triangular shape.

N - special ring for Razorbill. It has a triangular shape adapted to the bird's tarsus.

J - special ring for Common- and Brünnich's Guillemot. It has a triangular shape.

FA - ring designed specifically for Herring Gull and auks. Size of between 3 and 4.

JD - special ring for Tengmalm's Owl. It has the same diameter as 5 but is lower. Also used on Collared Dove, but then the ring should be cut by approximately 2 mm.

MD - Special ring for Eurasian Pygmy Owl. It has the same diameter as 6 but is lower.

K - ring with size between 6 and DA.

T - Special ring for Common Swifts. It has the same diameter as 8+, but is lower.

For White-Tailed- and Golden Eagle there are separate project rings.

In the final section of this document there is a list with the inner diameter of the different types of rings.
